“One of my favorite fish to guide anglers to is the Little Tunny, also known as the False Albacore, or, as we call them, albies. Cape Lookout, North Carolina, is the East Coast Mecca for big albies. Cape Lookout is challenging for both anglers and guides; with big wind and big fish and the ability to deliver a quick, accurate cast. Albies are fast, neurotic feeders and they seldom leave a school of bait to follow a fly -- so keeping the fly in the action is key. The Clouser Floater lets my anglers easily pick up 40-plus feet of fly line and with one back cast blast it back in the action. It is the best when the albies smash flies on the surface. The Clouser Floater will drive any aerodynamically challenged fly into the action and easily pick it back up and put it back in the fray.”
