“The Midge Tip is one of my favourite fly lines for fishing stillwaters. The one metre long (39 inches) clear AquaLux tip allows you to present larval, pupal and nymphal patterns at a variety of depths zones which is key when attempting to imitate the natural movement patterns of the real insect. The Midge Tip is used in combination with varied leader lengths and retrieves rates to cover water from just below the surface to depths of about 20 feet. This provides effective coverage of the most important feeding area, the shoal or shallow water zone of the lake.”
