



### **Nick Curcione on OutBound® Lines**

“Aside from some limited instances where I have the opportunity to sight fish on the flats, most of my saltwater fly fishing involves what is commonly referred to as “blind casting.” The object is to try and cover as much water as possible because the more water I can strip my fly through, the greater my chances of intercepting fish. What this translates into is long distance casting and regardless of how good you are, you need the right line. When I literally have to go the distance I go to the OutBound series. I refer to it as my launch pad line because with its 38-foot tapered head and small diameter running line it literally rockets out over the water. If the fish you are trying to entice are a long way off, it only makes sense to use a line that’s designed for the long haul delivery and this is where the OutBound shines as the distance champ. I can execute long presentations over extended bodies of water whether I’m facing a howling surf or standing on a pitching deck miles from shore.”
